If you connect a laptop to the Math Department network, then the following additional conditions apply.

- 6. The virus protection on your laptop and in particular its mode of operation and update must be approved explicitly by the technical support staff.
- 7. If you need external Internet access, then your laptop must use the Math Department proxy server.
- 8. We reserve the right to inspect and to alter settings on your machine to ensure that it conforms to University of Auckland minimum standards.
