Application for Appointment as a Teaching Assistant, 2007

Each year there are a limited number of teaching assistant positions available. Most positions will comprise simply of marking (usually between 30-60 hours work per semester). Some positions will involve combinations of working as a marker, demonstrator and/or tutor (these will comprise of between 7 and 15 hours work per week – usually around 10-12 hours per week).

Tutors and lab demonstrators are required to attend weekly meetings to discuss forthcoming material. Lab demonstrators, markers and tutors may also be required to attend initial training meetings.

The requirements for teaching assistants is generally a minimum of B+ grades and to have completed study to at least stage 2 in the relevant subject. Preference will be given to good students who are currently studying mathematics and/or statistics.

Applicants must either be a New Zealand resident or have a current work permit.

The hourly pay rate is \$16.00 for undergraduates and \$18.59 for graduates. (These rates do not include an annual leave allowance of 6%, paid at the end of the contract.)

You will be contacted if you are appointed as either a tutor or demonstrator or marker.
